SAFETY



NOTICE

The siting of this club by the river does not indicate that it is a safe place to swim, but rather that it is a traditional watering hole. There are inherent risks involved in river swimming. Minimise them. You swim & use these premises entirely at your own risk. You are responsible for your own safety and for the safety of others. Neither the Club, nor the Committee, nor any of its officials accepts liability for any loss or injury, howsoever caused.

RIVER SWIMMING HAS DANGERS. There are **NO LIFEGUARDS**. Come in a group, keep an eye on each other, & be prepared & able to life save each other. Parents: please keep a constant watch on your children. The water is **NOT** clear. In places it is deep, and *you can drown*. In other places it is shallow. If you wish to jump in, it is safest first to enter by the steps at the weir, or to go down either of the steps on the bank, to check the river for depth and for underwater obstructions (which may have come downstream since your last visit). Then check that the river below you is clear of swimmers to avoid injury to them. Diving is more dangerous, as you readily risk breaking your neck †, so please no diving. Do **NOT** jump off trees. The weir is slippery! Don't go in the river below it as there are rocks & debris there. Never swim on your own or after taking alcohol* or drugs. Although the water is tested for purity, there are health risks. Although the water is tested for purity, there are still health risks, which children especially are susceptible to, and they should not swim after heavy rainfall, even if the river is not running too fast. **DO NOT SWALLOW THE WATER.** Don't drink the water (Main risk: throat & tummy infections). Don't enter the water if you have an open wound especially one to the head (Risk: Weil's disease). The river is cold. Always acclimatise yourself to the river temperature ‡ in the shallow water by the weir. You must be a good swimmer and in good health, so do not swim if you are feeling ill, or you have any health condition which could endanger you whilst in the water. Do not swim when the river is in flood. Beware of getting entangled in any river weeds.

Swimming is only allowed above the weir as far as the Club field extends. Landing on the opposite bank or the island is not allowed.
